- Mary-Beth provided the June bank statement and ledger account list in advance of the meeting. Bank balance as of June 30, 2024 is \$173,211.73.
- GIC--\$80,000 allocated reserve funds has been renewed at an interest rate of 3.5% (vs the 3.25% from the previous year). Interest earned in the past year was \$1197.62.62 (3.25%). The GIC is locked in for a 30 day period, then can be accessed if necessary.
